\* All Years are approximate

\* Methuselah died the same year the flood occurred

\* Noah's dad Lamech died 5 years before the flood

\* Noah was born in 1056, the flood commenced when Noah was 600 years old (Gen 7:6). The year of the flood was 1656.

\* Shem is the lineage to Abraham

\* Gen 11:10 specifically states that Arpachshad was born "two years after the flood" reset 1656 to 1658

\* Beginning with Shem longevity drops off significantly

\* Gen 11:26 lumps Abram, Nahor, and Haran all together being fathered by Terah at 70 years old

\* Tough to track, but linage appears to now be tracked through Joseph

\*\* Joseph was 17 when sold into slavery (Gen 37:2)

\*\* Joseph was 30 when he entered service to Pharaoh (Gen 41:46) during seven years of plenty (Gen 41:47)

\*\* Joseph would be 37 when years of plenty ended

\*\* Both Manasseh and Ephraim were born before years of famine (estimate 4th year of plenty for Manasseh)

\*\* Jacob comes to Egypt after two years of famine, Jacob 130 (Gen 47:28) Joseph 39 (Gen 45:6)

\*\* Jacob lived for 17 years in Egypt (Gen 47:28)
